EXIT AT 57TH ST. GO WEST ON 57TH ST TO HYDE PARK BLVD. TURN RIGHT (NORTH) ON HYDE PARK BLVD TO 54TH ST. TURN LEFT (WEST) ON 54TH ST TO CORNELL AVE.

EXIT AT 53RD ST. GO WEST ON 53RD ST TO CORNELL AVE. TURN LEFT (SOUTH) ON CORNELL AVE TO 54TH ST.
